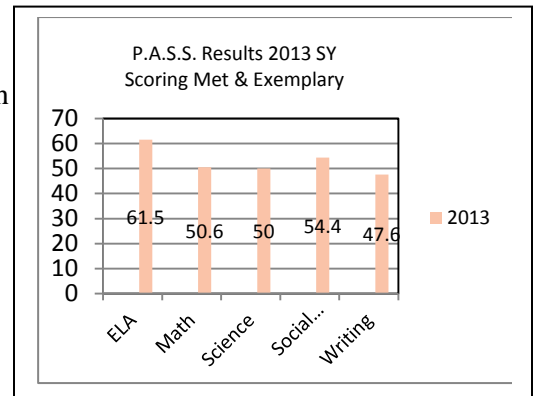


Report of Principal and School Improvement Council

Rivelon Elementary School serves 268 students in grades three through fifth in the southeastern, rural area of Orangeburg, South Carolina. We have strong ties to the community. Rivelon is a federally funded Title One school. We are dedicated to meeting the exceptional needs of every student and educating the “whole” child. We have embedded teaching and learning coupled with the development of literacy, language and numeracy to guide us in preparing our students for middle college and beyond.
