This year students in K-2 grades were administered the iReady assessment for reading and math. Above you will find fall and spring results. As indicated by the data, students moved from the lowest performing Tier 3 to middle and high tiers. In the Tier I, there was a growth of more than 20% of students in both reading and math moved into this category reducing the number of students at risk. Noted that within the data, it appears that students did not show growth in Tier 2 math, however students moved from Tier 3 bottom quadrant to the middle Tier 2.
