


Science

PLAN OF ACTION

3. Increase the number of students scoring meets and exceeds expectations on SCPASS Science and Social Studies assessments.
4. Provide Academic Assistance and Intervention for students who are not meeting the standards on state, district and school level assessments.
5. Increase the number of students reading on grade level to 100%.
