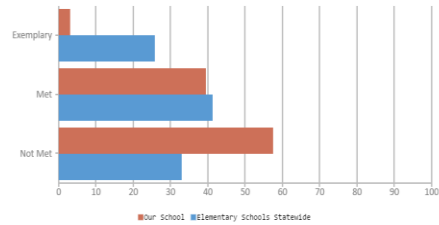
Exemplary: student demonstrated exemplary performance in meeting the grade level standard.

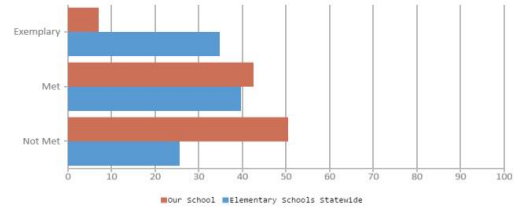
