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Student Achievement Goals

This year Anderson School District Five underwent the Reaccreditation process. These goals were developed as a result of that reflective process, data from school report cards, School Improvement Council input, and surveys from students and parents. These goals will be in place and reviewed annually 2013-2018.

1: To increase the percentage of students passing HSAP on the first attempt by 0.5% each year for the next five years. (Baseline 87.2%) 2: To increase the percentage of students passing HSAP by their senior year by 0.5% each year for the next five years. (Baseline 93.7%) 3: To increase our graduation rate 1% each year for the next five years. (Baseline 77.5%) 4: To increase our graduation rate for African-American males 1.5%



4: To increase our graduation rate for African-American males 1.5% each year for the next five years. (Baseline 66.7%) 5-8: To increase our End of Course Test Scores in each of the subjects below. (specific goals below)

- Algebra I by 0.5% each year (Baseline 85.6%)
- English I by 5% in year one and 1% each year after for four more years (Baseline 65.8%)
- Biology by 0.5% each year for the next five years (Baseline 85.0%)
- US History by 1% each year for the next five years (Baseline 75.1%)

Teacher and Administrator Quality Goal

To have 85% of all faculty IB and/or AVID trained. This equals 93 of 109 faculty members. (Baseline 46.8%)

School Climate Goal

To increase parent satisfaction with the level of safety and security of students on campus by 0.5% each year for the next five years as measured by the school report card survey. (Baseline 74.0%)
