SIC Annual Goals

 To establish the base line percentages of students meeting National College Benchmarks on the ACT Plus Writing.

Goal MET: Based on results from spring of 2015 testing, we know the following benchmark scores: English (17.3); Mathematics (18.7); Reading (19); and Science (18.9).

2. To establish the base line percentages of students achieving at least sliver status on WorkKeys.

Goal MET: Based on results from spring of 2015 testing, 71.8 % achieved at least a silver status

3. To reach 90 % graduation rate by 2018.

Goal NOT MET: Rate was 83.3% which is down 5% from the baseline of 88.3%. To meet the 90% rate we would need to grow by approximately 0.6% each year.

To close the graduation rate gap between African American females and their peers by 1.5% each year through
 2018 without a decline in the peer group.

Goal NOT MET: The gap increased 6.5%.

Increase percent passing on Algebra I EOC tests by 0.5% per year.

Goal MET: Increased 4.7% from base year

Increase percent passing on Biology EOC tests by 0.5% per year.

Goal NOT MET: Increased 0.8% from base year

7. Increase percent passing on English I tests by 1% per year.

Goal MET: Increased 6.5% from base year

8. Increase percent passing on US. History tests by 1% per year.

Goal MET: Increased 5.7% from base year

 To increase parent satisfaction with the level of safety and security of students on campus by 0.5% each year
