SIC Annual Goals

1. To increase the number of students who pass both parts of HSAP on the first attempt by 0.5% per year.
Goal: MET (Increased by 1.5%)
2. To increase the longitudinal HSAP passage rate by 0.5% per year.
Goal: NOT MET (Decreased by 0.1%)
3. To increase the on-time graduation rate by 1% per year.
Goal: MET (Increased by 5%)
4. To increase our African American male students' Graduation Rate by 1.5% each year for the next five years.
Goal: MET (Increased by 4.5%)
5. Increase percent passing on Algebra I EOC tests by 0.5% per year.
Goal: NOT MET (Decreased by 0.3%)
6. Increase percent passing on Biology EOC tests by 0.5% per year.
Goal: NOT MET (Increased by 0.3%)
7. Increase percent passing on English EOC tests by 1% per year.
Goal: MET (Increased by 7%)
8. Increase percent passing on U. S. History tests by 1% per year.
Goal: NOT MET (Decreased by 5.1%)
9. To have 85% of all faculty IB and/or AVID trained—equates to 93 of 109 faculty.
Goal: NOT MET (approximately 50% are AVID trained and 18 are IB trained)
10. To increase parent satisfaction with the level of safety and security of students on campus by 0.5% each year.
Goal: MET (Increased 6.7%)
