SIC Annual Goals (2013-2018)

- The average score on the ACT plus Writing will increase from the baseline scores to the following by 2018: English (18.3), Mathematics (19.7), Reading (20), and Science (19.9).
 Goal NOT MET. Scores for the spring 2017 administration decreased in all areas.
