Women United Preschool Pages Grants supports the East End Pup Tales program by providing nine books and reading strategies to future students ages 0-3

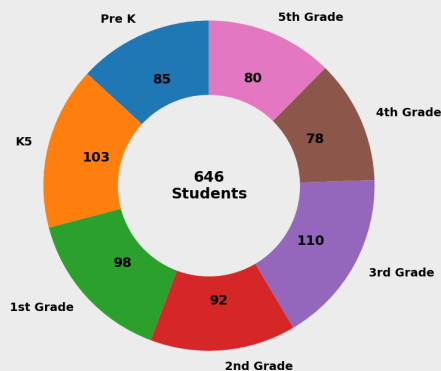
My First Library Grant

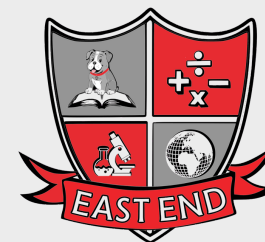

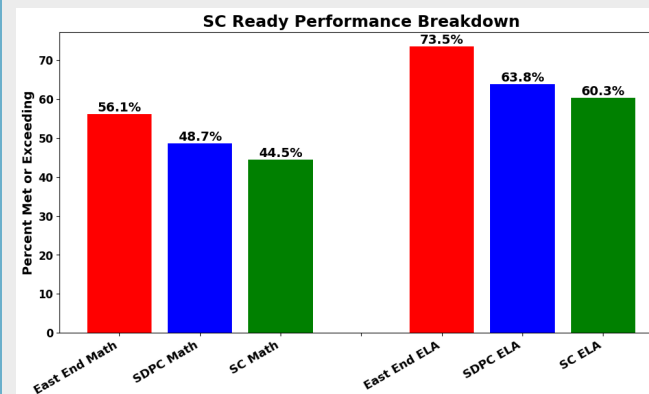
