Highlights of the Year

- 2025 SCReady ELA scores were 77% met and above for 3rd-5th grade students
- 2nd Grade iReady scores showed 72% of 2nd grade students on track for success in ELA and Math in 3rd grade
- 3-year analysis shows steady improvement of % of students reaching Met and Above in ELA. 70.3 % of students scored MET and Above in 2023 and 76% of students reaching the same goal in 2025
- 3-year analysis shows similar improvements with 60% of students scoring Met or Above on Math SC Ready in 2023 and 65% scoring the at the same level in 2025
