Curriculum

Eau Claire High School offers a multi-level instructional program, which includes Dual Enrollment at Midlands Technical College, Advanced Placement Program (AP), Honors Program, College Preparation Program (College Prep), and Special Education courses. Students may qualify for academic college credit by enrolling in Dual Enrollment courses and passing the corresponding exams in the following areas: Advanced Placement Literature and Advanced Placement US History. Students with special needs and disabilities are placed in special education classes according to their disabilities. Additionally, we provide diagnostic and remedial services, as well as credit recovery (Edgenuity) to our students.

Student Assessments: 2023-2024
