Curriculum

Eau Claire High School offers a multi-level instructional program, which includes Dual Enrollment at Midlands Technical College, Advanced Placement Program (AP), Honors Program, College Preparation Program (College Prep), and Special Education courses. Students may qualify for academic college credit by enrolling in Dual Enrollment courses and passing the corresponding exams in the following areas: Advanced Placement Literature and Advanced Placement US History. Students with special needs and disabilities are placed in special education classes according to their disabilities. Additionally, we provide diagnostic and remedial services, as well as credit recovery (Edgenuity) to our students.

Honors and Awards

- Six Eau Claire High School students were recognized as Richland One Academic All-Stars. These numbers continue to increase each year.
- A student was recognized as a "R1 future Hall of Famer" by R1 School District.
- One student was selected for the R1 Honors Dance Company. Fifteen students participated in the R1 Dance Festival host at ECHS.

- Eight students were inducted into the Eau Claire High School National Honor Society



Student Assessments: 2022-2023

- Algebra I EOCE had a 38.3% passage rate

- US History EOCE had a 28.9% passage rate
- Graduation Rate **decreased** from 84.1% to 79.7%
- 82 Students were recognized for being College or Career Ready..
