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OUR CURRENT GOALS

- By Spring 2021, 60% of students in grades 6-8 will score approaches or above on the SC Ready ELA Assessment.
- By Spring 2021, 49% of students in grades 6-8 will score approaches or above on the SC READY Mathematics Assessment.
- By Spring 2021, 69% of students will pass the End of Course Examination Program Assessment in Algebra I.
- By Spring 2021, Hopkins Middle will reduce the percent of core teacher turnover to 37.8%.
