School Highlights & Awards

The Ten80 Running team prepared for competition but were not able to attend the event due to Covid-19 closure

The MSAP program established all four magnet academies and offered CTE curriculum in each of the Career Pathways.

W.J. Keenan was awarded the MSAP grant to implement Richland One's first high school Magnet School featuring four academies: Hospitality & Tourism, Engineering, Government and Entrepreneurship.

The Entrepreneurship Magnet Academy students participated in the regional Virtual Enterprise conference and competition in Nashville, Tn. The first year students were one of the youngest groups to participate and performed masterfully.

The Robotics Team participated in the F.I.R.S.T competition in Myrtle Beach with their robot called Spiro-tron.

MSAP Teachers participated in over 165-hours of professional development.

W.J. Keenan has joined partnership with the University of South Carolina to launch the first national WIX club for student leaders and entrepreneurs.

W.J. Keenan's 2019-2020 Teacher of the Year is a candidate in the running for Richland School District One's Teacher of the Year.

W.J. Keenan JROTC Department placed 1st in the 2019-2020 District One Superintendent's Trophy Competition.

W.J. Keenan is the first Leader in Me High School in the state of SC. The Leader in Me Student Leadership Team hosted the Leader in Me Symposium featuring teachers from across the state that came to learn about our Leader in Me program.

W.J. Keenan's girls and boys basketball teams obtained region championship status, winning 3A upper state championship and making appearances at the Championship game at the Colonial Life Arena in 2019-2020.

W.J. Keenan Boys and Girls Basketball Team won the 2019-2020 SCHSL Class 3A Upper State Championship placing the Boys Basketball program with its eighth Championship to the history of the school. The Girls Basketball program with its fourth Championship.

W.J. Keenan Boys Basketball Coach, Zach Norris was recognized as 2019-2020 3A Coach of the Year.
