

SIC Goal: In support of the school's goal of having 57% of students in grades 6-8 meet or exceed expectations on SC Ready ELA, the SIC identified the goal of increasing literacy-rich educational experiences and providing students with culturally-relevant books for their home libraries.

Key Actions: The SIC, in collaboration with teachers across all disciplines, hosted Family Literacy Night. We welcomed **138 attendees**, **25 student volunteers**, and a host of community partners. Parents rated the event an overall score of **4.7 out of 5**. The event featured student performances, student learning demonstrations, interactive activity stations themed after popular books, doorprizes, and books to take home. The SIC partnered with **Richland Library**, **Columbia Fireflies Minor League Baseball team**, **Benedict College**, **and Communities In Schools**.
