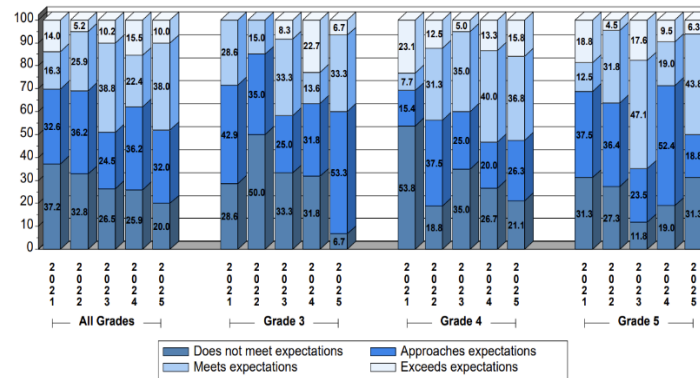
## 2025-2026 School Goals

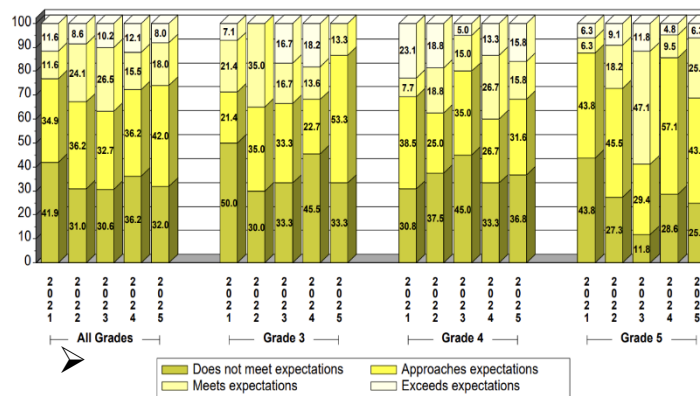
**2025 SC READY Five-Year Summary Graphs**
