


# Community Involvement

## Progress toward Academic Achievement and Growth

Each year students in Grades 3 – 5 participated in mandated SC Ready and SCPASS testing. All students in Grades 3 - 5 are assessed in Reading and Writing (ELA) and Mathematics. Students in Grade 4 are also assessed in Science, and students in Grade 5 are assessed in Social Studies. Moving forward Social Studies will not be assessed. This report reflects state testing results for spring 2019. Each school is given an overall rating. Schools also receive ratings for Academic Achievement, Preparing for Success, Student Progress (which compares the rate of growth with other demographically similar schools in the state), and Student Engagement. Concord's ratings are listed in the chart, along with academic achievement comparisons to students in the district and state.
