PBIS

Positive Behavior and Intervention Supports (PBIS) was established to address the behavioral and discipline systems needed for successful learning and social development of students.



GOALS

- By May 2013, student performance in reading, writing, math, social studies and science will increase by 5% as measured by PASS.
- By May 2013, the percentage of parents satisfied with school-home relations will increase from 87% to 90% as measured by the annual School Report Card survey.
- By May 2013, the percentage of students satisfied with the social and physical environment will increase from 91% to 94% as measured by the annual School Report Card survey.

RESULTS

- Our school made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) years in 2009 and 2010
- In 2010, 308 Hyatt Park students were Nationally Identified for Excellence in Physical Fitness
- In 2012, Hyatt Park Elementary received the Palmetto Silver Award
- Each year, our students demonstrate continued academic growth and improvement as measured by Dominie, Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) and other measures of academic performance.
