SIC Goals



- Goal 1:** Increase parent engagement at all school events, but especially events focused on literacy, by implementing strategies that encourage participation and fostering a sense of community.
- Key Activities:**
- SIC connected the school with a children's author who led a virtual author visit at Fall Family Night.
 - SIC piloted a Room Parent Program, an initiative where parents are paired with a homeroom to champion parental involvement and provide assistance to the teacher. Volunteers can be matched with any homeroom teacher in the school who desires additional support.

- Goal 2:** Complete and distribute the Annual Report to Parents to provide a comprehensive overview of the school.
- Key Activities:**
- The sub-committee participated in a webinar hosted by SC-SIC to ensure our school's report is thorough and accurate.
 - The sub-committee led the SIC in an audit of last year's report.

- Goal 3:** Organize volunteer clean-up and maintenance events to enhance the school's outdoor learning spaces.

- SIC members partnered with the Logan PTO and the Logan Foundation to host two clean-up days.
 - The clean-up days were held on Sundays and were well-attended by families. The activities included weeding, planting, adding mulch, installing lattice, and picking up litter.



Points of Pride

ABC Certification

Logan successfully applied and received re-certification as an ABC School by the Arts in Basic Curriculum Project. The statewide organization provides leadership in arts education and certifies South Carolina schools for their exemplary efforts to provide quality, standards-aligned arts education to all students.



Science Fair

Logan Students – Selena Casana, Selah Grace Detty, and Griffin Evans – won first place in the Chemistry and Biochemistry category at the USC Regional Science Fair for their project *Dark Matter Matters*. This honor comes after successfully progressing through the school-level and district-level science fairs.



Steel Band

The Logan Elementary Steel Drum Band is an extra-curricular activity open to third through fifth grade students. Each year, the band performs in a local holiday parade. Parents, students, and staff work together to decorate the parade float. In December 2024, the steel band was awarded *Best Musical Unit* in the Greater Cayce-West Columbia Chamber of Commerce Holiday Parade of Lights.
