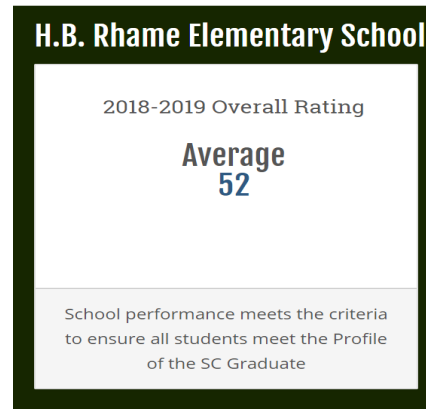
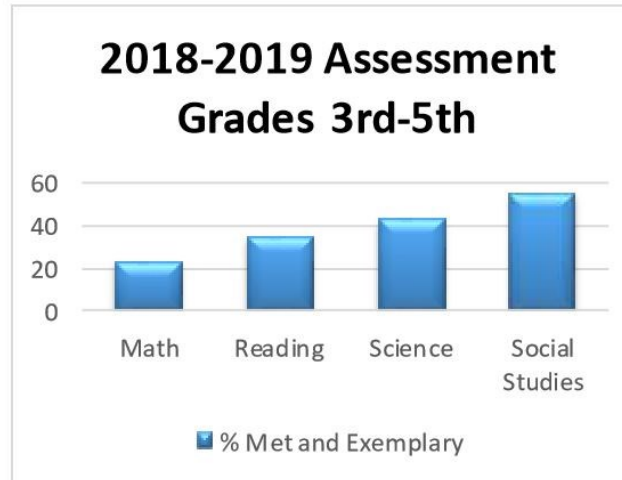
SIC Annual Goals
