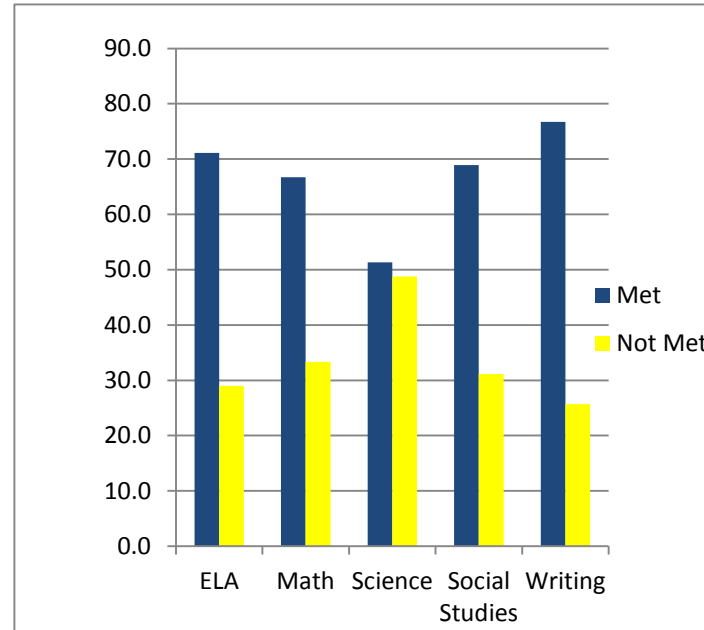

## Goals for Next Year

By 2016...

- students scoring passing in reading will increase by 5 percentage points as measured by ASPIRE.
- students scoring passing in mathematics will increase by 5 percentage points as measured by ASPIRE
- students scoring met or exemplary in science will increase by 5 percentage points as measured by PASS
- students scoring met or exemplary in social studies by 5 percentage points as measured by PASS
- 100% of staff will remain highly qualified
- 100% of staff will complete at least 3 differentiated professional development and will complete 2 offerings annually as measured by PD360
- 100% of staff will utilize PD360 to differentiate professional development offerings
- home-school-community relations will increase by five points annually
- students will increase positive behaviors in the school environment by five points annually
