


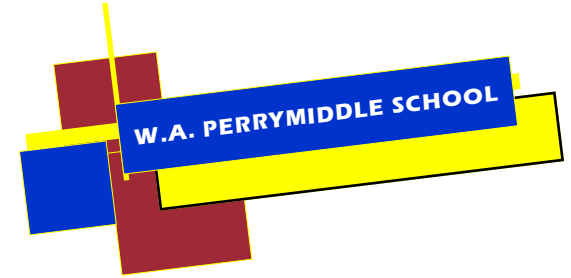

2010-2011 Visual Literacy Festival

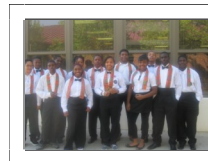
- Student won 1st Place in Photography.
