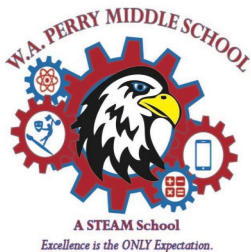
Parent Involvement Goal: W. A. Perry will increase parent involvement, redefining parent involvement.
