Title I Programming

About Us

Nevitt Forest Elementary School is a diverse neighborhood school situated within a short distance from local businesses in downtown Anderson. Nevitt Forest maintains high standards of instruction by utilizing Title I funds to provide effective instruction to meet the academic needs of all students. The staff works collaboratively with parents and community members to develop a comprehensive Title I plan, which addresses identified needs.

Parent Involvement

A variety of parent involvement opportunities are provided. These include:

Parenting Workshops and Academic Family Nights

Workshops which focus on a variety of topics are offered throughout the year. Academic Family Nights include Literacy Night, Math Night, and Science Night.

Parent Feedback

The school solicits parent feedback through a link on the school's website as well as multiple surveys and annual Title I and School Improvement Council parent meetings.

Title I Instructional Programming

Title I funds are used for the improvement of instruction in grades K through 5. Annual priorities are established using student performance data and input from parents and staff. Priorities for the 2016-2017 school year are:

Implementation of Writer's Workshop

Through the use of Title I funds, teachers will be provided with Professional Learning held in the summer and ongoing modeling and coaching throughout the school year.

Continued Support of Effective Math Interventions

Through the use of Title I funds, math intervention programs, Dreambox and Do the Math, will continue to be purchased.

Staffing

Title I funding provides staffing for two Reading Recovery teachers, a Math Interventionist, a certified early childhood teacher for Early Reading Intervention, and an Instructional Facilitator. This level of staffing provides effective instructional interventions for students. Additionally, these staff members provide instructional expertise and leadership which positively impacts the entire staff.

Positive Behavior Interventions and Support

The school has identified the need to continue the implementation of PBIS, a research-based framework, designed to provide students with a positive school climate and structures. Title I funds are used to provide student incentives and recognitions, along with professional learning for staff.
