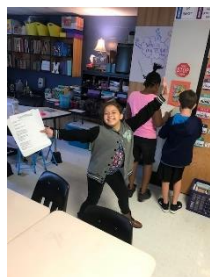
SIC Annual Goals

- The percentage of our students in grades 3 -5 who score Met and Exemplary as measured by the state assessment in Math will increase by 10 percentage points by 2022-2023.
- The percentage of our students in grades 3 -5 who score Met and Exemplary as measured by the state assessment in ELA will increase by 10 percentage points by 2022-2023.
- Title I funds are used to provide reading intervention, parent support and professional development to focus on improving writing and personalized learning for our students.

Student Achievement

- 34.7 percent of our students scored Met or Exemplary on the 2017-2018 SC Ready ELA assessment.
- 41 percent of our students scored Met or Exemplary on the 2017-2018 SC Ready Math assessment.
