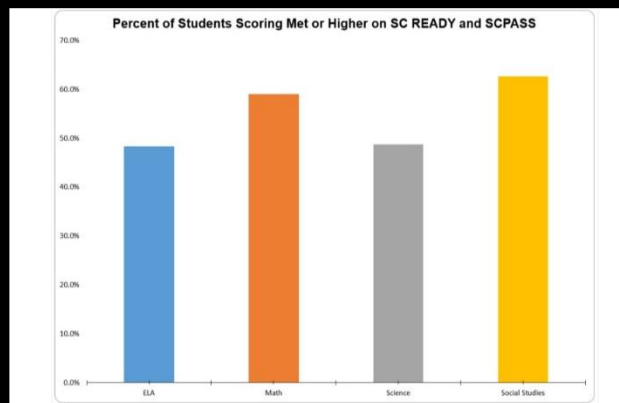
ALL ABOUT NORTH SPRINGS
