

AVID Elementary

(AdvancementVia Individual Determination)

For the 2018-19 school year, RTE continued implementation of AVID Elementary in grades Kindergarten through 5th grades. RTE hosted two AVID Showcase events (October 2018 and February 2019), allowing guest teachers and administrators from SC, NC and GA to visit RTE classrooms to observe teachers using AVID strategies during instruction. Seven K-2nd teachers received Foundations training during the spring semester, bringing the total number of faculty trained up to 26 (out of a total of 28 teachers). To continue supporting schoolwide implementation, eight faculty members will attend advanced training at the 2019 Summer Institute, including both Assistant Principals, Technology Learning Coach, Reading Coach, and four additional teachers. Future goals will include additional training opportunities that focus on Writing, Literacy and Technology.
