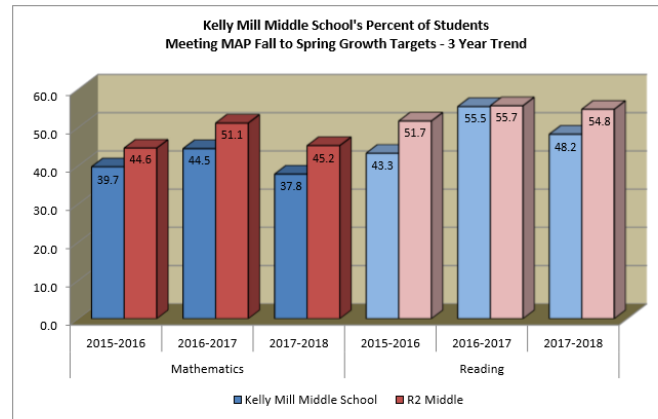
School Highlights & Awards

Kelly Mill had 23 South Carolina Junior Scholars, as well as award-winning music programs. We also have competitive teams for **Academics and Athletics**. Our parent and community volunteers play a major role in the success of our school. They have contributed over 1600 hours of their time. The staff at Kelly Mill strives to be premier by providing our students with innovative, challenging work that inspires and encourages them to inquire about the world around them. We are very proud to be recent recipients of the Med Pro 21 Grant for STEAMM. The AVID Program accelerates student-learning and encourages inquiry-based teaching methods. We are a National AVID Demonstration site. We also use technology as an integral component of instruction. We offer one-to-one computing for all students.
