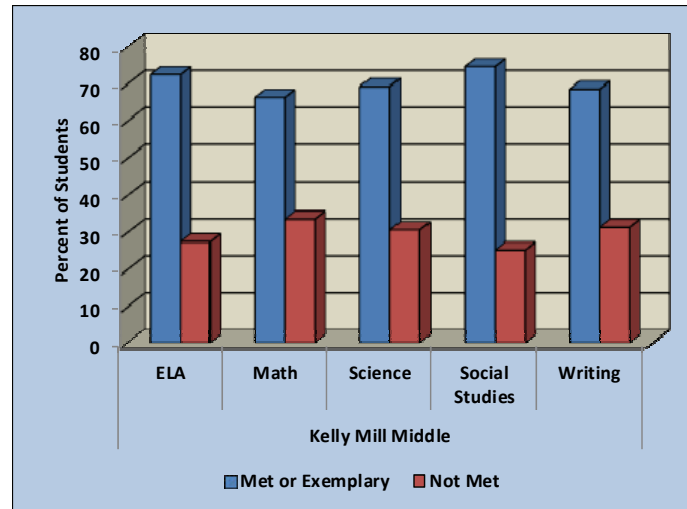
## School Highlights & Awards
