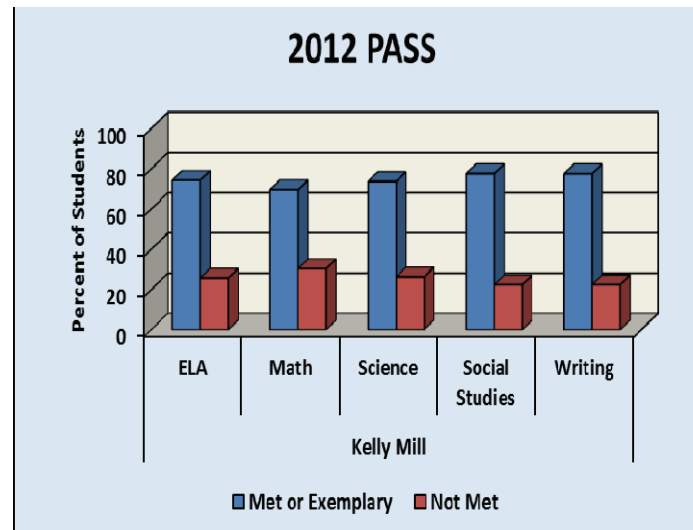
School Highlights & Awards
