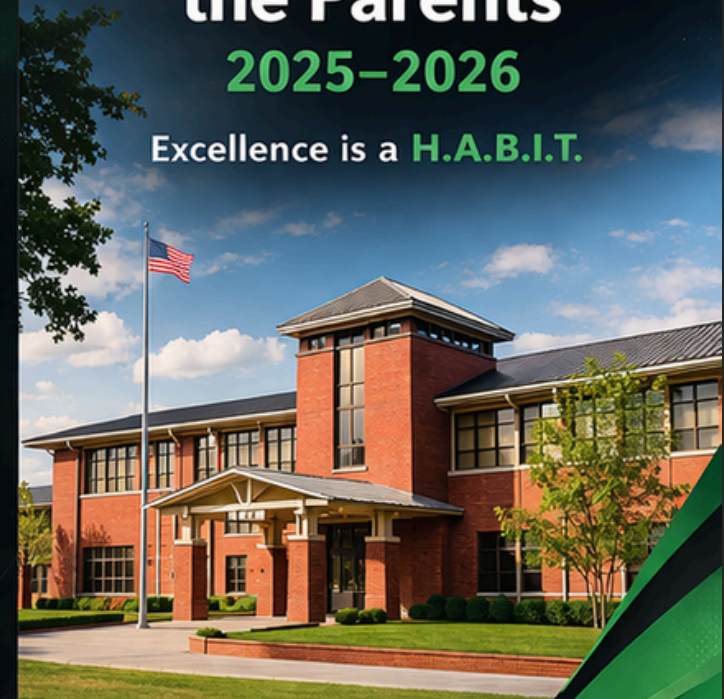


- **AVID National Demonstration Site**

Collaborative Teaching Practices (PLCs)

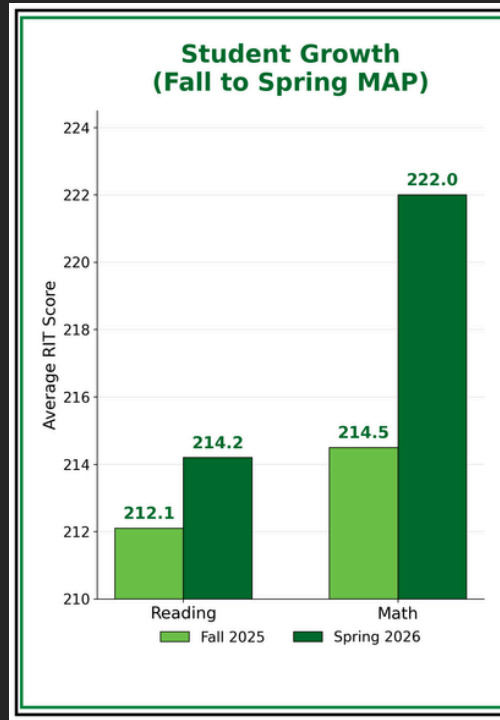
All teachers work together regularly to plan instruction, review student data, and ensure consistency across classrooms.
