Our parent's organization (PACE) continues to be a major part of our school. Working together, we are able to sponsor various events for our students. PACE is also able to contribute to some of our major projects such as school beautification and sponsored field trips for all students in pre-kindergarten - fifth grade. PACE provided a class set of Chromebooks that can be used by different classes in our school.

Community Outreach

- Our school community participates in commendable service learning projects. The American Cancer Society and American Heart Association have both benefited from our generous support.
- Weekly school and class newsletters are sent to keep parents up to date on all events.
- Blackboard Connect, a district-wide automated call system, notifies school community members of district and school happenings.

- Each grade level fully implemented South Carolina College and Career Ready Standards
- Fully implemented Balanced Literacy in all grades, K through 5th grade
- The computer lab is utilized for research, as well as practice skills in English Language Arts (Reading Eggs) and Math along with NWEA'S Measures of Academic Progress (MAP).
- Assessment scores are evaluated to help recognize both strengths and weaknesses in the curriculum. This information is also used for helping students set improvement goals.
- All teachers participated in weekly Cluster meetings. This initiative enabled teachers to work together to learn best practice strategies as well as fine tune lesson plans so that we may better serve our students.
- Teachers focused on aligning our formative and summative assessments to the South Carolina College and Career Ready Standards.
- A monthly reading incentive program is underway for all grade levels to enhance their reading performance. This initiative encourages students to read for pleasure and for better comprehension.
- Hollywood benefits from a phenomenal sheltered ESOL program for our Hispanic students. ESOL students receive further support provided by ESOL tutors.
- Math teachers implement a problem solving based – hands-on program during Balanced Math.
- MAP assessment in grades 1-5 and PASS testing for students in grades 3-5
- Individual conferences are held throughout the year with all parents, students and administration to discuss student performance.

- Students in fifth grade math scored 31.15% higher than the national average on ACT ASPIRE state readiness
- Students in fifth grade science scored 22.62% higher than the national average on ACT ASPIRE state readiness
- Students in third grade math scored 14.06% higher than the national average on ACT ASPIRE state readiness
- 83% of all fourth grade students scored met or exemplary on Social Studies SC PASS
- 87% of all fifth grade students scored met or exemplary on Social Studies SC PASS

School Environment

Hollywood is a Positive Behavior Interventions and Support (PBIS) school. In our sixth year of implementation it is our priority to reinforce positive behaviors while constantly teaching our school wide expectations.
