

- Second through fifth grade students have 1:1 devices.
 Students practice skills in English Language Arts (Reading Eggs) and Math (Reflex Math) daily.
- NWEA'S Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) is administered to all students. Data collected from MAP is used to drive instruction.
- Assessment scores are evaluated to help recognize both strengths and weaknesses in the curriculum. This information is also used for helping students set improvement goals.
- All teachers participated in professional development that is driven by student data. This initiative enabled teachers to work together to learn best practice strategies that are relevant to student needs.
- Teachers focused on implementing strategies to foster vocabulary development and total participation in the classrooms.
- A monthly reading incentive program is underway for all grade levels to enhance their reading performance.
 This initiative encourages students to read for pleasure and for better comprehension.
- Hollywood benefits from a phenomenal sheltered ESOL program for our Hispanic students. ESOL students receive further support provided by ESOL tutors.
