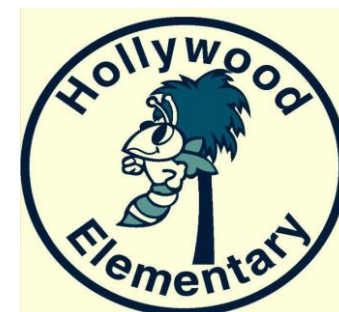

PACE is also able to contribute to some of our major projects such as school beautification and sponsored field trips for all students in pre-kindergarten – fifth grade. PACE provided funds for Chromebooks that will be used to complete classroom sets due to the increase in our school population. PACE always celebrates our teachers/staff during Teacher Appreciation Week.*

- School website and our Hollywood Facebook & Twitter pages update the community on school happenings.
- School's marquee is kept current.

**Curriculum**

- Fully implemented South Carolina College and Career Ready Standards throughout each grade level.
- Fully implemented Balanced Literacy/ Literacy Footprints in all grades, K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Google Chrome Tablets and Chromebooks are used in kindergarten and 5<sup>th</sup> grade to help develop technology readiness skills and deepen learning in the classroom.
- 4K through fifth grade students have 1:1 devices. Students practice skills in English Language Arts (Reading Eggs) and Math (Reflex Math) daily.
- NWEA'S Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) is administered to all 5K-5<sup>th</sup> grade students. Data collected from MAP is used to drive instruction.
- Assessment scores are evaluated to help recognize both strengths and weaknesses in the curriculum. This information is also used for helping students set improvement goals.
- All teachers participated in professional development that is driven by student data and focused on implementing strategies to foster vocabulary development, total participation in the classrooms, and technology implementation.
- A monthly reading incentive program is underway for all grade levels to enhance their reading performance. This initiative encourages students to read for pleasure and for better comprehension.
- A Reading Tutor conducted reading interventions with 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students.
- Hollywood benefits from a phenomenal sheltered ESOL program for our Hispanic students. ESOL students receive further support provided by ESOL tutors.
- MAP assessment in grades K-5 and SC Ready testing in grades 3-5 and SC Science PASS testing for 4<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Individual conferences are held throughout the year with all parents, students and administration to discuss student performance.

**School Data**

***\*Due to COVID-19, SCREADY/ SCPASS were not administered in 2019-2020.***

- Multilingual learners scored 3.5% higher than the state average on meeting progress toward English language proficiency targets.
- 45.5% of 3rd-5th grade students are projected to Meet and/or Exceed expectations on the SCREADY Math assessment according to NWEA MAP.
- 42% 5K-2nd grade students are reading two or more levels above grade level based on DRA spring text levels.

**School Environment**

Hollywood is a Positive Behavior Interventions and Support (PBIS) school. In our eleventh year of implementation, it is our priority to reinforce positive behaviors while constantly teaching our school wide expectations. Hollywood ROCKS! Students are expected to be Respectful, Organized, Cooperative, Knowledgeable, and Safe. This initiative coupled with student leadership opportunities and community service projects helps to foster positive Academic and social growth. Hollywood Elementary School has a School Resource Officer stationed at our school each day.
