Our parent's organization (PACE) continues to be a major part of our school. Working together, we are able to sponsor various events for our students. PACE is also able to contribute to some of our major projects such as school beautification and sponsored field trips for all students in pre-kindergarten - fifth grade. ### Community Outreach

- The computer lab is utilized for research, as well as practice skills in English Language Arts and Math along with NWEA'S Measures of Academic Progress (MAP).
- Assessment scores are evaluated to help recognize both strengths and weaknesses in the curriculum. This information is also used for helping students set improvement goals.
- All teachers participated in Professional Learning Communities (PLC). This initiative enabled teachers to work together to fine tune lesson plans so that we may better serve our students.
- Teachers focused on aligning our assessments to the Common Core State Standards.
- A monthly reading incentive program is underway for all grade levels to enhance their reading performance. This initiative encourages students to read for pleasure and for better comprehension.
- Hollywood benefits from a phenomenal sheltered ESOL program for our Hispanic students.
- Math teachers implement a problem solving based – hands-on program during Balanced Math.
- MAP assessment in grades 1-5 and PASS testing for students in grades 3-5
- Individual conferences are held throughout the year with all parents, students and administration to discuss student performance.

## School Data

- 90.0% of our third grader Social Studies students met or exceeded expectations on PASS
- 85.3% of our fourth grade ELA students met or exceeded expectations on PASS
- 82.8% of our fifth grade SS students met or exceeded expectations on PASS
