- PowerSchool SwiftK12, a district-wide automated call system, notifies school community members of district and school happenings weekly. Hollywood Monday Messages are sent each Monday to all parents/guardians to keep parents up to date on all information and events.
- School website, Hollywood Facebook & Twitter pages, and the school marquee update the community on school happenings.

Curriculum

- Fully implemented South Carolina College and Career Ready Standards throughout each grade level.
- Fully implemented Balanced Literacy/ Literacy Footprints and Write from the Beginning in all grades, K through 5th grade.
- 4K through fifth grade students have 1:1 devices. Google Chrome Tablets and Chromebooks are used in kindergarten and 5th grade to help develop technology readiness skills and deepen learning in the classroom.
- Students practice skills in English Language Arts and Math, using Imagine Learning Language & Literacy, Math, and Math Facts daily.
- NWEA'S Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) is administered to all 5K-5th grade students 3 times a year. Data collected from MAP is used to drive instruction.
- SC Ready testing in grades 3-5 and SC Science PASS testing for 4th grade is administered.
- Assessment scores are evaluated to help recognize both strengths and weaknesses in the curriculum, as well as inform our Multi-Tier Systems of Support (MTSS) process.
- A monthly reading incentive program, Rockin' Readers, encourages students to read for pleasure and for better comprehension.
- Hornet Intervention/Enrichment Time is built into the master schedule for all students.
- Our RISE Intervention Program serves 1st-5th grade students needing reading interventions.
- An Enhanced Early Education Interventionist serves 4K and 5K students in needed reading and math interventions.
- Hollywood benefits from a phenomenal sheltered ESOL program for our Hispanic students. ACCESS testing is administered to ESOL students to monitor their progress.
- Qualifying students in 3rd-5th grade participate in our Gifted and Talented program.
- Individual parent conferences are held throughout the year with all parents, students and administration.
