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SIC Annual Goals

The School Improvement Council (SIC) of Landrum High School continued its focus on student and teacher well-being during this unique school year. For the first time in our educational history, students attended school entirely from home last spring and were given the option to do so again this school year. Due to this unique situation, many schools were exempted from the typical state mandated testing, including End of Course testing. Students and families were only able to attend school face to face for only two days each week from August until November. During the week of Thanksgiving, our students were given the opportunity to attend school for the full five days each week. The SIC focused on giving students and teachers the social and emotional support that they needed through the numerous unique challenges that we encountered this school year.

The SIC worked diligently with our administrative staff to help design a community theme renovation to the main rotunda area of our school. The

goal is to incorporate numerous visuals and landmarks in the Landrum community into the facade of our school, ranging from the incorporation of downtown Landrum and Hogback Mountain into the background of our newly upgraded hallway markers.
