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Purpose of SIC

- assist in the implementation of school improvement programs and activities;
- monitor and report on progress toward improvement goals in the annual SIC Report to the Parents and with the principal in the narrative to the SC School Report Card;
- provide other assistance as requested by the principal.



School Report Card 2023

- Graduation Rate 92%
- Class of 2023 earned \$1.5 Million in scholarships
- Average SAT Composite Score of 1103
- Average ACT Composite Score of 20.3
- Average PSAT Score of 1036
- 56% of graduating students met the standards to be classified as career ready
- 39% of graduating students met the standards to be classified as college-ready
- 70 students were enrolled in Dual Enrollment courses, earning a total of 122 Dual Enrollment credits.
- 100% of students enrolled in US Government scored at or above passing on the civics test
