MMS Course Guide HONORS PROGRAM

The honors program is designed for the academically talented student who is self-motivated and who is preparing for honors or advanced placement programs at the high school level and beyond. The following three (3) criteria will be considered for placing students in honors classes: 1- An average of 90 or above in the subject 2- A score of "EXEMPLARY" in the subject from their spring Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS). 3- A RIT score within a RIT Range of Exemplary on the Measures of Academic Progress Test (MAPS) A student may elect to take honors classes in math and /or English/Language Arts.

RESOURCE PROGRAM

A resource program is available to students with special needs. Prerequisites: Teacher referral and Individualized Educational Plan (IEP).

RELATED ARTS PROGRAM

Exploratory courses are offered to all students and are one semester each. Performing Arts classes (band, orchestra, and chorus) are year long courses. One semester of health/physical education is required.
