Community Involvement

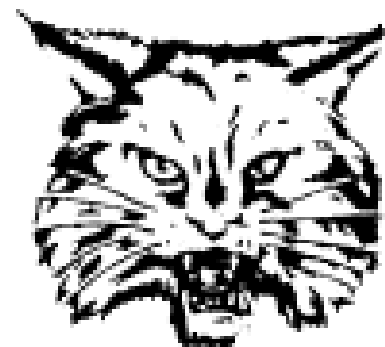
- **Relay for Life** — gold level award for raising over \$5000 for 2013.

- **Volleyball**- won the regular season and conference tournament championships; 2 players were named All Conference



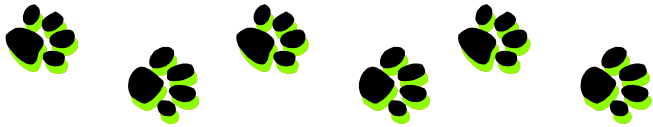
