

## Updated Activities

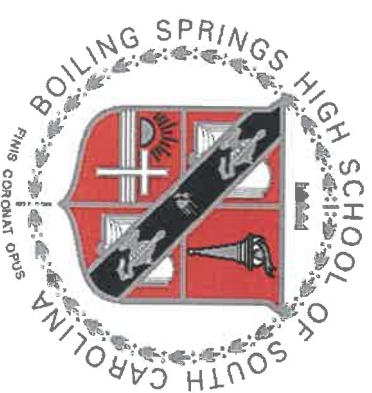

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## School Community Achievements

### Academic

- The Graduation Rate was **91.6%** for the class of 2019, which is above the state of South Carolina's average.
- The Boiling Spring High School Senior Class of 2019 posted an average SAT score of **996** and an average ACT score of **18.6**.

- Over 80% of all students who graduated from Boiling Springs High School's Class of 2019 continued their education at a post-secondary institution.

### Fine Arts

- The Boiling Springs High School Bulldog Marching Band achieved a 5<sup>th</sup> place finish during the 2019-2020 South Carolina State 5A Marching Band Championship and earned 7<sup>th</sup> place at the Bands of America Championship.
- Mrs. Kimberly Jones produced her 56<sup>th</sup> Drama Production, *Farce of Habit*, during the 2019-2020 school year. It was outstanding!
- The Chorus placed 17 students in the South Carolina Region Choir program. One of our students was selected to participate in the Prestigious South Carolina All-State Choir.
- The Orchestra program placed 4 students in the South Carolina All-Region program. Two students were selected for the South Carolina All-State Orchestra Program.

### Athletics

- The 2019-2020 Boys Varsity Football team had one Senior Athlete to participate in post-season All-Star Games. Marquise Graves participated in the North-South All-Star Game in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina.
- The 2019-2020 Girls Golf Team had one Senior to participate in the South Carolina North-South All-Star Golf Match. Kyleigh Antley performed well and proudly represented Boiling Springs High School. Additionally, Mary Kathryn Telleo was selected as the State Player of the Year in Girls Golf.
