

South Carolina Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (SCPASS)

The academic areas assessed include English Language Arts, math, science, and social studies. All 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders are tested in ELA, math, and writing. Fourth graders participate in all areas, while 3rd and 5th graders participate in either science or social studies. The table below shows the percentage of Mayo students who scored "Met" or "Exemplary" for the 2013-2014 school year.
