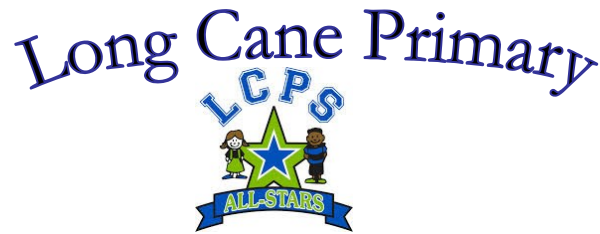

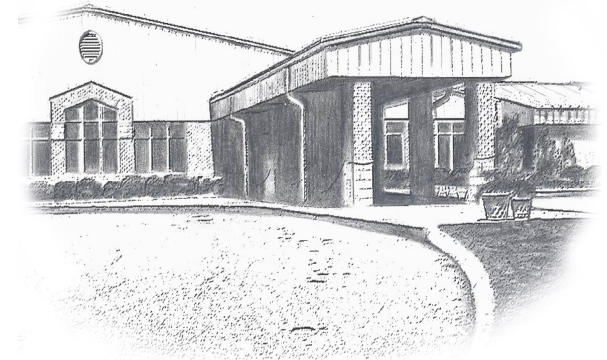

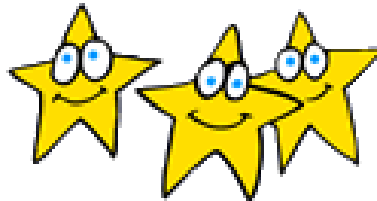

- Continuing P.T.O. meetings with Parent Orientation Night, Parent Help Sessions, and Family Fun Nights are held each year to enhance parent involvement .
- An annual Related Arts night promotes the importance of an overall educational program that includes art, music, and physical education.
- Mentors from the Abbeville community and Abbeville High School students assist with the Character Education and reading programs.
- Character Education is an integral part of our school. Classroom guidance, small group sessions, individual counseling, mental health services, and reward celebrations all enhance this program.

Promoting excellence in academics, as well as overall student performance is recognized at L.C.P. by All-STAR celebrations, Student of the Month recognition, Honor Roll and Accelerated Reader celebrations.
